Do you agree with this statement? Could this statement be said of you?

Plumb-line/Back to centre

What causes our trust in God to drift? Jen suggested that placing God central again is not a major task, but a minor adjustment for most of us. Do you agree?

Look what I’ve given you (not ‘if you are good you might get this’) *Num 13:1-2*

God has made many amazing promises – and God keeps His promises. What promises has God made to you – general and specific?

“I do believe, help me in my unbelief”

Have you ever felt/said this? Which side of the statement is your focus – your ‘belief’ or ‘unbelief’? How does your focus impact your decisions and actions? What promises/truths of God do you need to hold onto more tightly?

Don’t allow enemies to overwhelm *Num 13:27-29*

Ten of the spies allowed their insecurities/fears to determine what they saw – “we are like grass-hoppers”. How does the way you see yourself impact how you see situations? When we are with God, our enemies become like grass-hoppers. Do you agree? Where do you need to believe more?
