### **“the stones would cry out”**

Do you think Jesus' revelation about the stones wanting to cry out in praise was limited to that particular moment in time or does all creation long to praise God?

### **Who God is and what He has done/still does**

When the Bible gives us a glimpse into Heaven/the presence of God, worship continually surrounds His throne. Why do you think this happens?

Write a list describing God's attributes and characteristics – who He is and what He's done/does.

Is worship the natural response to this list?

### **We sometimes lose our perspective**

The religious leaders on Palm Sunday did not believe that the worship being given to Jesus was appropriate. They refused to worship and endeavoured to stop others from worshipping. What things stop you/us from worshipping God? Do our words/actions ever stop others from worshipping God?

### **A plus B?**

When we give God the worth He deserves, seek God's Kingdom first, we encounter more of God in and around our lives. Is it really as straightforward as that? (Matt 6:33) God has made the first move towards us (John 3:16, Romans 5:8) - does this lead to more worship or complacency from us?
