Title: RISK (3) – An Invitation

Reading: John 1:29-42

1. Who gave you an invitation to 'come and see' Jesus? Why did you accept?
2. **DON'T KEEP IT TO YOURSELF:** What is the significance of John's description of Jesus as, 'the Lamb of God'? Why do you think he used this title as the invitation? (see Genesis 22:8; Exodus 12:1-7, 21; Leviticus 5:6; Isaiah 53:7) What happens to this 'good news'? (John 1:35, 37-39, 40-41). What stops us giving an invitation? READ Romans 1:16. How might we overcome the things that stop us inviting?
3. **WIDEN YOUR EVERYONE:** READ Luke 14:15-24. What do you think about this story? What does it tell you about peoples' heart for God? What does it tell you about God's heart for people? Is there any attitude or action that you need to change to widen your everyone? Who do you exclude (intentionally or unintentionally)? Who could you choose to include in your 'everyone'? READ Romans 10:13.
4. **AN INVITATION CHANGES A DIRECTION:** What are the changes in direction for the people in John 1:29-42? How did your life change when you accepted the invitation to come and see Jesus? Think about how you might make an invitation – how could you start a conversation, find a connection, make an invitation to come and see?
